RE: JUDGE JANICE WARDER, CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT No. 1, DALLAS, TX

Dear Commission:

I would request that the Texas Commission on Judicial Conduct please mail to me at the above address information on how to file a complaint against a Texas Judge for "judicial misconduct." I have requested similar assistance from the Texas Senate Committee on Jurisprudence five (5) times in the past year (addressed to Senator Royce West) and as of this date have not received a single response.

My complaint is against Judge Janice Warder and it encompasses her conduct before and during my capital murder trial in Dallas, Texas beginning in May of 2001 and continuing to this date. I will state that my trial attorney, Mr. Paul Johnson, told me before my trial that he and Judge Warder were appointed to my trial to make sure I was given the 'death penalty' and not as advocate and unbiased trier of facts. Mr. Johnson stated to me that Judge Warder and he were both former Dallas Assistant District Attorneys and that fact alone should tell me how the trial would turn out, "in my death."

I have written the above to my Direct and Habeas Appeal attorneys over the past four (4) years and not once have I received a response. I have made numerous 'judicial notices' to both the trial court judge (Warder) and to the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals with equally no response. And I even notified the U.S. Attorney General and the F.B.I., but the F.B.I. wrote back that it was a State or Local problem. Including the "tampering with witnesses", "hiding of evidence" and "suborning of perjury" which appears to have been allowed during my trial under the excuse of "judicial discretion."

I will enclose my last writing to the Court on August 29, 2005 in the form of a PRO SE ANSWER TO STATE'S ORIGINAL ANSWER in which the forth and final page outlines the type of conduct I wish to complain of and bring forward for action by the State of Texas. I will also enclose a copy of a NOTICE to the C.C.A. regarding the same type of issue on November 7, 2005.
